Dear Valued IEEE Members,

Here is another piece of good news emphasizing the focus of IEEE development in India. One of the recommendations of the Sections Congress 2008 (sphere headed by the India Adhoc Committee) was to spread the membership benefits to India and other countries also which are otherwise exclusively available for USA only.

Accordingly, one of these benefits chosen by MGA this year is expansion of IEEE job site which was possible only due to the great thought process and sincere follow-up made by the Indian representatives at Sections Congress & IEEE headquarters. Really, it would be great to hear that India has been chosen as one of the destinations to expand the job site in 2010. The success of job site expansion to India would also depend on the number of companies IEEE is able to rope in and also the number of members who will use this initiative. The details of this new initiative of IEEE are available in this newsletter separately. All Members especially students and GOLD can separately register for this initiative and take advantage. However, this being the starting phase of the pilot project, registrants are cautioned to have more patience for the response. The details of one such company by name ITTIAM Systems was already communicated by us to Region 10. ITTIAM is hiring actively this year from India (for details contact samir.dhond@ittiam.com).

It has been understood from IEEE Bangalore Section / PES Chapter that their International Workshop on "Smart Grid and Renewable Resources" held at Mysore on 13th -15th May, 2010 was a grand success having around 460 participants attended the event. Double this number of registrants could not be accommodated due to shortage of conference facilities for whom the IEEE PES Bangalore Chapter may explore the possibilities of repeating the event during August/September, 2010 once again at Bangalore exclusively for IEEE Members. A separate communication was promised by organizers in this regard. The outcome of this conference was formation of a core committee along with several sub-committees pertaining to the various components for Smart Grid Operation in India. These committees from IEEE would prepare a white paper and submit to the India Smart Grid Task Force, which could serve as Government of India focus point for activities related to the Smart Grid in India. IEEE - Standards Association Seminar and Outreach Events.

The IEEE - Standards Association Corporate Advisory Group (CAG) conducted a Seminar on “Global standards at IEEE” on the 9th of March. The IEEE SA Corporate advisory group constituting Mr Dennis Brophy - CAG Chair, Phil Wennblom - Director International standards regulation and Technology program, Mark Epstein - Senior VP Qualcomm, Robert Oshana - Member CAG, Karen Bartleson - Member CAG, Ashwin Gumaste - IITB presented to the seminar participants on the IEEE standards development and standards in wireless communications - 802.1, Test and debug - 1149.7, Power Line communication -1901, Smart Grid and standards in Software life cycle standards.



The IEEE - SA had also conducted six outreach events from 10th – 12th of March to interact with experts in the areas of Wireless communications, Smart Grid, Microelectronics, Nanotechnology, Photovoltaics, Cloud computing & Software Security.

The IEEE - SA outreach team constituting Mr Dennis Brophy - chair, Jeff Green , Karen Bartleson and Robert Oshana presented on the development of IEEE standards and the confluence of other industry standards with the broad set of IEEE standards in the areas of Wireless communications, Smart Grid, Photo voltaic, Microwave engineering, Software standards , Electronics Design automation and Microelectronics .

Mr. Shashi Dhara Dongre of L& T Infotech had hosted the Outreach session on Networking and Wireless communications at the Whitefield Industrial park on the 10th of March. Experts from Industry and Academia participated in this session including Dr. Kiran Kuchi, Dr. Bhaskar Ramamurthy, Dr. Debabrata Das - IIITB and Dr. Abhay Karandikar.

The ISRO session was hosted by Dr. Surender Pal and Mr. VVS Srinivasan exclusively for participants from India Space Research Organisation and Department of Defence Research & Development Organisation.

Smart Grid and Photovoltaic initiatives in India with the need for standardization were discussed at the CPRI IEEE - SA outreach event on the 11th of March . This outreach session was well attended by a panel of industry experts including Dr Shivkumar Kalyanaraman of India Research labs - IBM, Dr. Kota Murali - SRDC - IBM, Mr Babunarayanan (CPRI) , Mr Srinivasa Raghavan (Society of Automotive Engineers) and Mr. Satya Prasad (SEMI).

Professor Anurag Kumar and Chockalingam had hosted a session on “Academic research and standardization” at the Indian Institute of Sciences to increase the awareness and participation of academia in standardization.

Prabhat Singh of McAfee software systems had hosted the outreach session on Software on the 12th of March. Industry experts including IEEE Fellow Dr. Raghuram Krishnapuram IRL - IBM , Dr. Gopal S Pingali , Thatagat Varma- Yahoo , Microsoft and Mandate discussed the areas for standardization in Cloud computing , Data Analytics and Software Security. Jeff Green, member of IEEE SA – CAG, presented on standardization process and specific standards in the areas of Cloud Computing, Security and Software Engineering Process. Dr. Gopal S. Pingali, Program Director Global Cloud Center of Excellence – IBM presented on the current state of Cloud computing and mentioned about Desktop services.

IBM had hosted the EDA – VLSI outreach event at the IBM EGL venue. Mrs. Pamela Kumar, Director ISTL invited the industry leaders to actively participate and contribute towards standards Development efforts from Bangalore – India. Robert Oshana, Freescale Semiconductors presented on some key IEEE standards in the areas of VLSI Design, Verification and Test.

Under the eminent leadership of Mrs. Pamela Kumar and Sri Chandra of Freescale Semiconductors, there will soon be a IEEE standards chapter in Bangalore to bring together experts in leading technical areas to participate in shaping the standards for the next generation

- RTE (Right To Education), Census of India and BS IV specifications for automotive emission were licked off on April 1, 2010.
- 470,000 students take JEE examination (for admission to IIT's)
- "Flying ash" grounded several flights for more than a week in the Central Europe affecting global travel
- The Indian Spacecraft launch met with failure
- The entire presidential team of Poland died in an accident.
